Not sure if anyone else thinks so, but this is cool--I will even interrupt my 8 hours of sleep (okay, 10) to get up for this! Hope it's true!

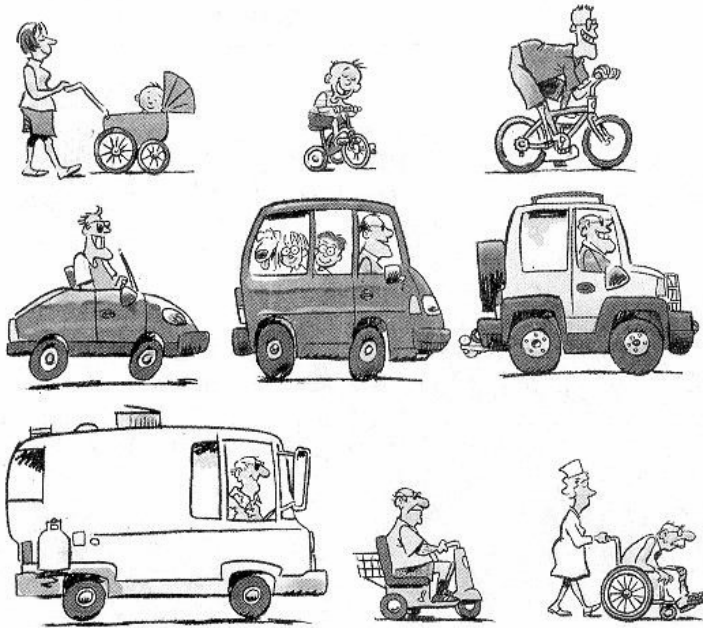
