'I said, 'No, my former doctor said that all red meat is very unhealthy!'

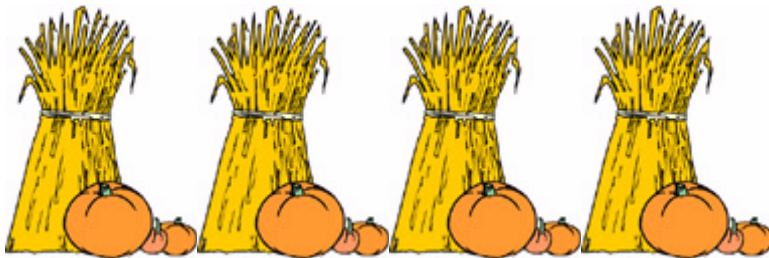
'Do you spend a lot of time in the sun, like playing golf, sailing, hiking, or bicycling?'
