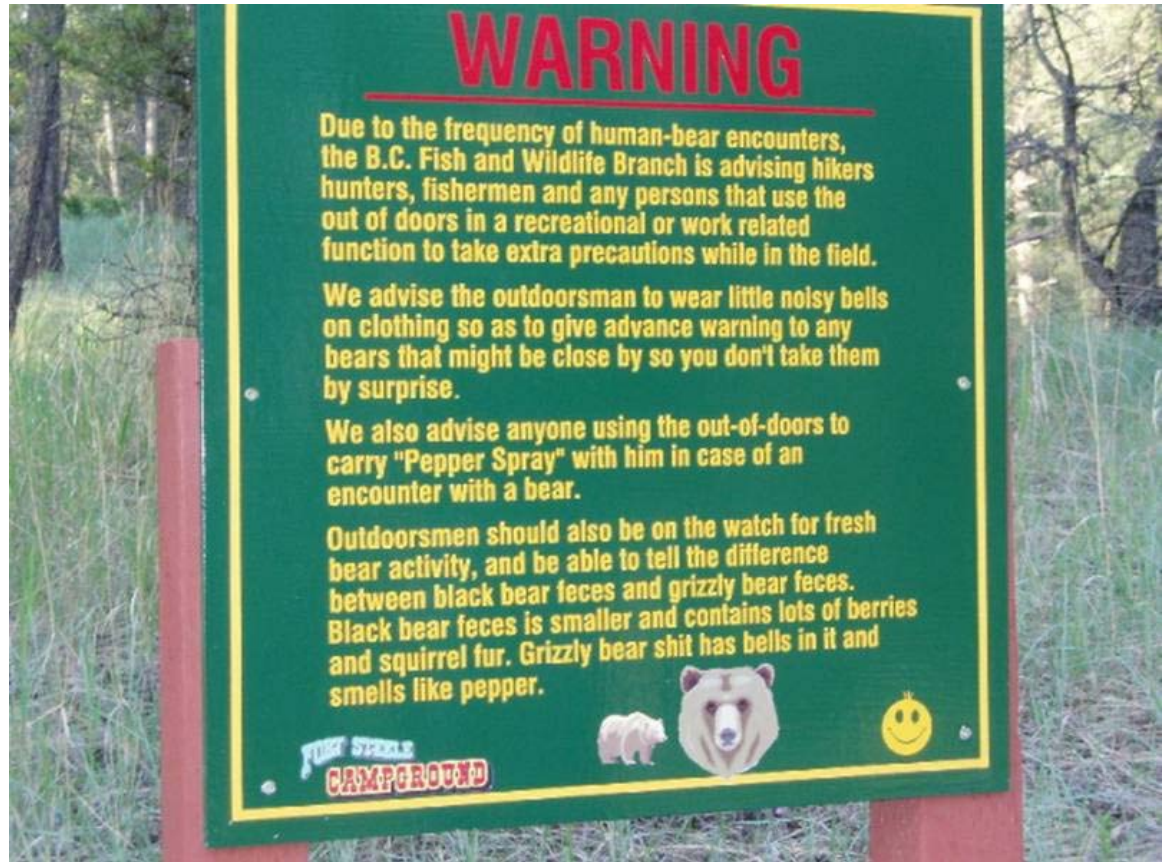
They had a wonderful, wonderful time.
